From Ashes to Art: Creating a Better Tomorrow

SAN JOSE, CA June 4, 2024 – Breathe California will present Anti-Tobacco Poster Contest Showcase and Press Event featuring poster art created by youth to educate about the dangers of tobacco use, flavored tobacco, menthol, and vaping. Three winners will be selected and presented a prize for their artistic contributions in support of public health. Breathe California invites community and coalition members, press, stakeholders, partners, students, and friends and family to attend the event, view the youths' artwork, enjoy food and refreshments, and to meet and take photos with young artists, elected officials, and health experts.

The event will take place on Friday, June 7th from 12pm to 3pm at Breathe California's office at 1469 Park Avenue in San Jose. The showcase will be followed by a press event with information about current tobacco use and product trends in addition to a youth panel discussion covering their work in tobacco prevention and education efforts over the years.

Our Keynote Speakers, the Honorable Rosemary Kamei, San Jose Vice Mayor and the Honorable Susan Ellenberg, Santa Clara County Board of District Supervisors, District 4, will be joined by Guest Speakers Natalie Andrade, School Climate Senior Specialist in the Santa Clara County Office of
